Dear Professor Meselson,

Thank you so much for your letter and for your valuable article, which we will study and use. (By this I mean we will use the information , not the text.)

In the light of your letter I wrote to Mrs Myrdal a somewhat modified request that consideration of the question of submitting the CS gas exemption might be put to the International Court of Justice. I suggested that the Swedish Government might feel such an initiative would be useful, but I have not yet had a reply. I think you may well be right that ANY suggestion that a re-definition is possible may be a backward step, and it was only that some of us felt that some legal decision on CS gas would help to bring about a change of heart in the British Government, that we raised it at all.

Your nominations will be put to the Committee at the next meeting, and I will of course keep you informed.
