Dear Marshall,

It was good to speak with you on the telephone the other day. As yet I have not heard from EPA regarding the date of the proposed advisory panel meeting. It would help me in planning my calendar to have some information on this.

I hope I made clear to your colleague with whom I spoke that I believe I can make a much more useful contribution in a group considering toxicology than in a group dealing with ecology.
