
I have looked over the edited manuscript, and think it is masterful. I agree that the Leonard piece beginning on page 128 looks a little out of place, but am not overly troubled by it -- and don't see an easy way to shoehorn it into the next section. I would keep it as it is.

If you will administer the final editing rites to the manuscript and return it to Ms. Diane Bendahmane, Director of Publications, at this address, we will get to work on it immediately. She will be doing the actual editing. As you may have heard, incidentally, the rumors about my leaving sometime this summer are true.

Tom Hughes customarily has signed a brief foreword in Carnegie Endowment publications. He could do so in this as well; probably just a short note explaining the genesis of the project and identifying the various sponsors, leaving more substantive information to your introduction.
