Dear Professor Messelson:

The major purpose of the Albert Einstein Peace Prize Foundation Planning Meeting is to get a clear understanding of and general agreement on the objective and goals of the Albert Einstein Peace Prize Foundation. These objectives will then become part of the official document preparatory to securing the charter (the draft of the Articles of Incorporation and the draft of the By-Laws will be reviewed).

We must also establish ourselves officially as a charitable operation as well as follow all procedures required in order for the Foundation to be recognized by the I.R.S. as a public foundation.

Therefore, these several papers attached (once again including the documents as approved by Otto Nathan, Trustee for the Albert Einstein Estate) will be reviewed in detail in order to clarify and make such changes as may be warranted. It would be hoped that all these items plus the table of organization of the Albert Einstein Peace Prize Foundation can be discussed in the morning session.

The afternoon then would be dedicated to the Prize itself -- its nature, dates of award, means of awarding, etc., and the responsibilities and method of choosing of the Award Nominating Committee for the Prize.
