Dear Dr. Meselson:

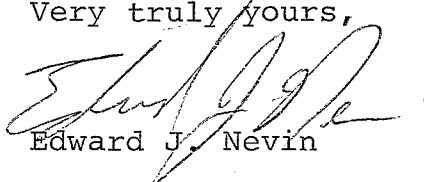
I am the attorney for all the surviving children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren of Edward J. Nevin, who died on November 1, 1950, at Stanford Hospital in San Francisco. An action has been filed in the United States District Court here in San Francisco and is to be called for trial on November 26, 1979.

I have reviewed your testimony before the United States Senate Subcommittee on Health and Scientific Research given on May 23, 1977. I would very much appreciate the opportunity to arrange for a formal deposition, to be taken by me with the United States Attorney present, in your office so that that deposition can be read at our trial.

The U.S. Attorney has indicated his availability between September 4 and September 11, 1979. An ideal day for me would be Wednesday, September 5, 1979.
