Enclosed is the edited manuscript with revisions. In the interests of accuracy, please let me know of any further revisions you may make. Also, Dennis Flanagan offered to let me come down to New York to look at the galley proofs during the brief period you will have them. Please let me know approximately when this will be, so I can keep my calendar flexible.

We would like to have a picture of the Chemical Munitions Munitions Disposal System in Utah. I enclose for this purpose an aerial color photograph plus a line drawing as well as a legend for a Figure 8. I also enclose a color photograph of a U.S. infantryman wearing full chemical protective gear. Since the man is upright, more of the equipment is visible. If the reproduction would be as good as that of the British black and white, you may wish to substitute the U.S. soldier and change the figure legend accordingly. Also, I understand that you have another photograph showing U.S. protective equipment which may be the best of the three. Here also is a picture of Soviet soldiers in full protective clothing decontaminating a battery of multiple rocket launchers. If you decide to use it, I will provide a longer caption. Lastly, I enclose a drawing of the M687 155-MM GB binary artillery projectile, which may be of some use to the illustrator, plus two illustrations of the non-binary one.

Please return any photographs that you do not plan to use as soon as possible and please make sure that all of the photographs, both these and the earlier ones, are ultimately returned to me except those which were asked in a previous letter to be returned to Julian Robinson.
