

A dinner has been planned for the Symposium participants at the Kenwood Country Club on the evening of April 10th. An open bar at 6:30 P.M. will be followed by dinner at 7:30 P.M. Please notify us if you will be unable to attend.

In addition you will be paid a consultant's fee of approximately \$190 for each day of the conference.
