Dear Julian,

I have talked with Garry Piel and the German Scientific American (*Spektrum der Wissenschaft*) editors are definitely not going to run the article. The foreign editions always leave out one of the articles in the American edition and ours is the one they are leaving out this time. We are free to have it published in German elsewhere. The German Scientific American editors hope, however, that we will not submit it to *Bild und Wissenschaft*, their detested competition.

What I need to know is whether you will take the ball from here or whether I should. We could consider *Die Zeit*, the *Frankfurter Allgemeine Zeitung*, or, in Switzerland, the *Neue Zürcher Zeitung*. All of these, however, and publications like them would probably require us to rewrite, which I would rather not take time to do. Let me know whether you want to try to find a publisher or whether you want me to try from here. Naturally, I would prefer you to do it.
