I am writing to invite you to serve as a workshop leader at the Committee's Women's Leadership Conference on US-Soviet Relations, to be held June 1-3, 1983 at Georgetown University in Washington, D.C. The topic of the workshop is Chemical-Biological Warfare, and will follow several speeches on the general topic of "US-Soviet Security Relations." The speeches will be Thursday, June 2 from 9:00-10:45 a.m., with workshops from 11:00-12:00. About 30 women will take part in each workshop; participants in other Committee conferences have found these small discussion groups especially valuable. I have enclosed a copy of the Conference agenda to give you an idea of the scope of the program.

The goals of the Women's Leadership Conference are to provide concise timely and objective information about US-Soviet relations, and to encourage local and national organizations to integrate these issues into their own activities. Last year's highly successful Conference on National Security drew 300 women from 30 states, representing 135 organizations, for three days of intensive briefings on national security issues.

The Committee for National Security is a non-profit, non-partisan leadership organization formed in 1980 to encourage informed participation in the national security debate.

The Committee will be able to provide your airfare and \$50 toward your expenses on the day of the workshop. I hope you will be able to take part in the Conference; I look forward to hearing from you at your earliest convenience.
