Dear Professor Dioumayev,

I understand that SIPRI has invited you to attend a round-table discussion in Stockholm on 6 December concerning chemical warfare. The round-table will include experts and the ambassadors of many countries attending the Stockholm conference on disarmament. I have also been invited to attend along with Julian Perry-Robinson.
