Culture No. T-340 of Fusarium sporotrichioides was originally obtained from the Commonwealth of Mycological Institute at Kew, England. The original number is CMI 175449. The latest catalog of fungus cultures at CMI should give you additional information on this culture. I do not have the catalog at hand.

We do not have any isolates of Fusarium species in the section Sporotrichiella in our collection that were originally isolated from warm areas and produce T-2 toxin. All of our T-2 toxin producers come from cold temperate areas.
