I appreciate your note of May 16 and look forward to talking with you again before too long. I will call in advance the next time I know when I am coming to Washington.

Admiral Doyle of the Center for Law and National Security telephoned asking if I would be willing to participate in a debate with you about yellow rain. I let him know that I will be glad to do so more or less any time after I get back to Cambridge in August.

You mentioned that you might be able to help me obtain some unclassified data about the mycotoxin findings. I would like to have a list of biomedical samples from alleged victims of chemical warfare in Southeast Asia giving the date of collection of each sample and stating whether or not trichothecenes were reported to be present. Similarly, I would like to have a list of environmental samples from alleged attack sites in Southeast Asia telling the date of collection of each sample and whether or not it was reported to contain trichothecenes.
