Last week I inquired at the State Department about the disposition of the Porton report regarding alleged chemical warfare in Southeast Asia. I was told that the report has been requested but has not yet been received. I will let you know if I learn that the report has finally come across.

The problem with my memo has been ingeniously solved by Porton suggesting to me that, in fact, no memo exists! In other words, it is not to circulate. By all indications, full cordiality is restored.

UK officials wishing to see the latest US report giving the case of those who believe that trichothecene warfare has occurred in Southeast Asia might wish to request through appropriate channels the document cited in the enclosed reference.
