The next meeting of the CSIS study group on chemical warfare policy issues will be Wednesday, July 16 (and not July 9 as indicated on the original agenda). We will meet in room B-338 of the Rayburn House Office Building, from 8:00 to 9:30 a.m.

We will explore in more depth some of the issues broached in earlier discussions concerning European security. Jim Leonard will make a presentation on the chemical weapons free zone. We will also discuss the deployment/deterrence issues raised in the Gold/Kroesen/Wagner letter (another copy of which is enclosed) and will press into service one of the letter's authors to provide a brief presentation. Acknowledging that this is a lot of ground to cover in 90 minutes, we may decide at the end of the July 16 discussion to continue it at an informal group meeting on the following Wednesday, July 23. On July 30 we will discuss future policy directions.
