Dear Bob:

Here are two amateurish enlargements of a SPOT photo taken 0719 GMT August 31, 1988. If the coordinates and map features, specifically roadways, of the DoD map are good to within 1/2 km, the site  $56^{\circ}46'50''$  N  $60^{\circ}35'15''$  E should be within the indicated circle. I can get a completely independent check from the SPOT photograph itself but I haven't done it yet. I would not be surprised if the site is outside the circle, but I am pretty sure it cannot be outside by more than 1/2 km. I believe that our INF inspectors are stationed at an installation about 9 km east of the circle and that their permitted radius of travel for recreation is much larger.
