Tomorrow evening I plan to drive to Cambridge and stay at

On Thursday, November 21, I shall enter the Brigham &
Women's hospital, as a joint patient of the Urology and Vascular
Surgery Services.

On Friday I shall be operated on for:

- 1.) Nephrectomy and ureterectomy of my right kidney to
remove a transitional cell carcinoma, (so far localized
by all tests.)
- 2.) Reconstruct and replace my abdominal aorta for an
aneurysm.

Accepting these established facts, I consider myself
extremely lucky. They were discovered early, 1) by three short
episodes of silent hematuria, and 2) as an "incidental" finding
during the CT scan. I have no symptoms at all. The prognosis is
good. The hospital the best!

I suspect my hospital recovery period will be "more than one
week" followed by a convalescent period of unknown length and
location.
