LORA LUMPE

Lora Lumpe is a Senior Research Analyst at the Federation of American Scientists in Washington, DC, where she directs the Arms Sales Monitoring Project and co-directs the Zero Ballistic Missiles Project. In addition, Lora administers the Federation's work on chemical and biological arms control, following these subjects closely, and producing the quarterly *Chemical Weapons Convention Bulletin*. She compiles and edits the monthly *Arms Sales Monitor*, which reports on and analyzes U.S. arms sales and arms sales policies.

Lora has been at FAS since December 1988.

Prior to working at FAS, Lora was a research assistant on arms control issues at the Center for Defense Information and the Committee for National Security, both in Washington, DC. She also worked as a project assistant at the Inter-American Dialogue of the Aspen Institute and, in a volunteer capacity, taught English and computer word processing to Salvadoran refugees in Washington.

She earned a B.A. in Political Science and in Soviet Studies from Indiana University in Bloomington, Indiana in May 1987.

Lora was born in Indianapolis, Indiana on 29 November 1964.
