- [3] And why the Ceramics-Pipe Shop for Burmistrov? My notes have it as the "Tile Shop".

I have had an E-Mail from Borisov. The important bits are

Energetikov Lane is only 100m long with 10 houses and is opposite the bus-stop Juzhnaya podstansiya. [An earlier E-Mail had it at 116-118 Sel'korovskaya. I cannot find such a small lane where he indicated, but there is a winding country lane to the WNW out to some orchards and fields ... or is on the other side of Sel'korovskaya?]

Sverdlesmash: 29 Elizavetinskoye shosse

Rubber Factory RTI: by tram stop on Titova.

Ural NII Agriculture: 20 kms SE at Istok

The absence of cases out of the Polyclinic #2 area would indicate to me that there was no primary eastward airborne spread out of the compound.
