Dear John:

This is in response to your memo of November 24:

1. The term "G.I. bill" is not very appropriate. Soldiers risked their lives during war and interrupted their careers. Workers displaced from military jobs in industry did nothing of the kind. Personally, I support increased effort for education and training for former military workers no more than for the large number of undereducated and undertrained people in other parts of the work force. So I would ask that we rename the proposal and try to reshape it to remove the impression of elitism.
2. I think that the second proposal "Create a world..." should be put first instead of second.
