I am writing to you on the suggestion of Professor Francesco Calogero of Pugwash council, who has recommended you as one of the key participants for the conference we are organizing now.

Our conference, to be held under the auspices of NATO as a NATO Advanced Research Workshop, will bring together the leading experts on the problem of chemical ammunition dumped in the North Sea and in the Baltics. The idea of the conference is to estimate precisely the actual danger of the Allies' and Soviet dumps, and to elaborate a concrete program of needed follow-up actions. The conference is planned to take place in Moscow, June 2-5, 1994.
