Here are two recent publications about TCDD, the contaminant of Agent Orange on which much research and controversy has focused.

I have not paid close attention to the field since we developed methods for TCDD analysis at very low concentrations, some twenty years ago. I enclose three old papers about that work. We now study bdelloid rotifers, attempting to learn whether they really evolved without sexual reproduction and recombination.
