Dear Prof. Meselson,

This is in regards to the timing conflict between the hearing in Ishevsk and the public hearing on chemical weapons to be held in Gorny, Russia in October. I have spoken to Stephan Robinson, Director of the Legacy Programme of Green Cross International who has informed me that inside of Russia there has been negotiations among the respective hearing organizers. The Russian side has agreed to change dates so that the two hearings do not conflict; however, the American answer "is missing so far."

I realize you are leaving to visit your father, but I would appreciate it if you could get me a contact person with the American Academy of Sciences who might be able to shed some light on the scheduling issue. I am sorry to do this by fax, but your phone has been busy.

I will stay in touch with your office about what happens.

I hope your father makes a full and speedy recovery.
