

Dear Matt,

I have your letter of 5 January and I shall arrange to meet you at the airport on Thursday, 28 January. If I am held up by our Executive Board meeting which is underway at that time I shall arrange to have a note left on the bulletin board at the airport, which you will see immediately after leaving the passport clearance desk. You will stay with us unless you wish strongly to book at an hotel. Although we live 10 minutes out of Geneva there should be no difficulty in transport arrangements, so that you can be free to do whatever you wish in town.
