Your suggestions look fine.

MONDAY: My flight gets in at 7PM Monday, and I will have a checked bag to pick up, so James will be picking me up around 7:20 and taking me to the Hotel. Agenda:

A. I am nearing finishing my finding aid for the Katz documents (it is already 54 pages long and I am only partway into 1985). I can give the latest version to you with the Data CD-ROM on Monday evening if you'd like.

B. I think the first order of business ought to be a short discussion of what is in the Katz archive and how I have arranged the finding aid. That way you can get a jump-start on looking it over, and also you can get an idea of what is in your archive that I have not yet seen (which will be a lot!). We could do that Monday evening unless we are too tired, otherwise first thing Tuesday.

C. I have put together a detailed critique of the mycotoxin assay data that are present in the Katz documents, so far concentrating on the data made public in the State Dept Special Report #104 of Nov 1982, but ranging into early 1983. I think this will be of considerable interest to you. Perhaps this would be good to do Wednesday AM. It will likely highlight some things you will want to examine in the Katz archive.

D. I have a hypothesis regarding the YR controversy that is independent of the mycotoxin assay question, and would appreciate your thoughts about it. You may be able to point me towards some important sources.

These points may take up most of our time together on Tues AM, letting me look over what documents I need in your archive on Tues PM. Wednesday will be a good day for us to work together: we could share guidance if you want to look through the Katz documents while I look into some of your papers. It is a jigsaw puzzle and there doubtless are pieces in both archives that deserve to be joined. And I am like one of the blind men of Hindustan, and have my hands around only one part of this elephant called YR.

Matthew:

Your schedule below is fine. I have in-laws in Boston I can have dinner with on the 18th if they are free.

My thanks for having Sandy Ropper send the YR finding aid. It will help me in planning what to look over.

I will bring the CD, and what finding aid I can cobble together. I will try and bring significant paper documents, but the sheer bulk of the material makes transporting the whole of it difficult. And I don't know what is already in your archive.

It is a real bird's nest of documents, scanned into 563 digital documents of from 2 to 150 pages each, and organized into only short runs of related material, with many gaps in the digital document numbers. Some scans clearly show the organization of the original organizational files, others are isolated documents and may be undated. Considerable duplication is present. However, I am near to getting them into some sort of chronological order and making sense of the original archive.

I am eager to look over your archive: as I have said, my YR sources have been limited to what open-source material I can gather and the Katz documents, and there are gaps I need to fill.

I will be happy to work in the archives Tuesday when not needed by John Rubin. Since I am tentatively scheduled with Rubin at 11:30AM, I will need some directions to the archive for Tuesday morning. Tuesday may be chopped up because we are giving interviews throughout the day. It looks like we three may all be free around 2:30-4:30, but with filming, and schedule changes who knows? There are three "presentations" I would like to make sure I can share with you, Jeanne, and whoever else in Cambridge might be interested, when we can all get together. It might be Tuesday, or maybe Wednesday. I would like to offer:

1. an overview of the material in the Katz documents, and my appraisal of the "inside narrative" of the US Govt (or at least the AFMIIA) YR investigation it presents. Even if I can offer little new to you, at least it may expose gaps in my knowledge that need filling.
2. a discussion of the analytical validity of the mycotoxin determinations used to justify the YR claims, based on the Katz docs.
3. I would like to propose a new hypothesis regarding the YR episode. Run it up the flagpole and see who salutes.

I would also like to get your opinions as to what additional work would be needed and what venues would be appropriate for presentation/publication of the YR material discussed above.
