Dear Joe,

I have discussed your letter of September 30 with Matt. He and I will attend the meeting, and the American Academy of Arts and Sciences will cover the cost. Matt will speak to Don Glaser this weekend to determine whether Don could also come (funds are available), and if Don finds this difficult Matt will try to obtain a commitment from him to participate in the technical activities of the Study Group if our plans go forward.

I shall arrange to arrive in Stockholm on Thursday, 21 October, directly from here. Matt and I may be able to arrange to fly together, but I can't say at this time. I would plan to leave Stockholm around noon on Sunday the 24th for a one day visit to Geneva, since there is no extra cost involved for the flight ticket and I can usefully attend to many matters there. Please let us have any details available as to hotel accommodations, place of meeting, etc. Matt and I agreed that formal working documents would not be of much value for the meeting, but we shall give it further thought.

I am enclosing a copy of a letter I have sent to Malek urging him to attend. I still consider that it would be very desirable to have someone from Chalfont's office attend as an observer, and I hope you can arrange it.
