2. THE THAI MFA OFFICER CONCERNED WITH CN TOLD US HE UNDERSTANDS THAT THE OK EARLIER INVITED THE U.N. EXPERTS COMMITTEE TO VISIT KHMER ROUGE ZONES. HE SPECULATED, HOWEVER, THAT THE NEWLY FORMED COALITION GOVERNMENT OF DEMOCRATIC KAMPUCHEA MAY NOW HAVE TO REITERATE THE INVITATION. THE MFA OFFICE SAID HE THOUGHT THE RTG WOULD WELCOME A U.N. TEAM VISIT TO KHMER RESISTANCE ZONES IN CAMBODIA.

3. AS FOR THE POSSIBILITY OF ANOTHER UN TEAM TO THAILAND, THE MFA POSITION REMAINS THE SAME AS FOR THE PREVIOUS TRIP. THE RTG WILL NOT EXTEND AN INVITATION, BUT, IF THE U.N. TEAM INDICATES
