ENDOPFS DREW ON REF A TO DISCUSS HIS EARLIER INTERVIEW
CONCERNING CBW USE IN SOUTHEAST ASIA AND HIS REPORTED
STATEMENT THAT THE SRV WAS USING CBWS LEFT BEHIND BY
DEPARTING US FORCES.

2. BUYUNG READILY CONCEDED HE HAD MADE THE STATEMENT
CONCERNING ALLEGED US ORIGINS AS REPORTED (REF D),
AND SAID HE OBTAINED THAT IMPRESSION BOTH FROM
