1. FRG HAS JUST CIRCULATED AS A UN DOCUMENT (A/38/281, DATED JUNE 22, 1983) A RESPONSE TO THE USSR'S AND VIETNAM'S LEGAL AND OTHER OBJECTIONS TO GENERAL ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 37/98D. (RESOLUTION 37/98D SUGGESTED PROVISIONAL PROCEDURES TO UPHOLD THE AUTHORITY OF THE 1925 GENEVA PROTOCOL ON THE ILLEGAL USE OF CHEMICAL AND BIOLOGICAL WEAPONS.)

2. IN THE LETTER TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL, THE FRG REP MAINTAINS THAT THE PRINCIPAL GOALS OF RESOLUTION 37/98D ARE SIMPLY TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH THE ACTUAL OBLIGATIONS EMANATING FROM THE 1925 GENEVA PROTOCOL AND FROM INTERNATIONAL CUSTOMARY LAW, AND CONTRIBUTE TO BETTER
