CBW TEAM LEADER DON STADER ACCOMPANIED BY LO LARRY THOMAS GAVE A BACKGROUND BRIEFING ON APRIL 6 TO RESIDENT TIME MAGAZINE CORRESPONDENT JAMES WILWERTH. WILWERTH REQUESTED THE BRIEFING AS PREPARATION FOR HIS CONTRIBUTION TO A POSSIBLE TIME COVER STORY ON CHEMICAL WARFARE. THE BRIEFING GIVEN WAS ESSENTIALLY THE SAME AS THAT PREVIOUSLY GIVEN TO NEWSWEEK CORRESPONDENT FRANK GIBNEY. NEWSWEEK SUBSEQUENTLY REFERRED TO THE EMBASSY UNIT IN ITS APRIL 2 ARTICLE ON CHEMICAL WARFARE NOTING "...THE GROWING SOPHISTICATION ABOUT LOOKING INTO REPORTS OF CHEMICAL WARFARE."

THE SUBSTANCE OF THE BRIEFING WAS ON THE METHODOLOGY BEING USED IN DATA COLLECTION. PREDICTABLY, THE REPORTER RAISED QUESTIONS REGARDING METHODOLOGY USED PRIOR TO ESTABLISHMENT OF THE UNIT. THESE QUESTIONS WERE NOT ANSWERED IN DETAIL. INSTEAD, THE REPORTER WAS URGED TO DISCUSS THE WORK OF DR. AMOS TOWNSEND DIRECTLY WITH HIM. OTHER INQUIRIES REGARDING EARLIER

CBW TEAM LEADER DON STADER ACCOMPANIED BY IO LARRY THOMAS GAVE A BACKGROUND BRIEFING ON APRIL 6 TO RESIDENT TIME MAGAZINE CORRESPONDENT JAMES WILWERTH. WILWERTH REQUESTED THE BRIEFING AS PREPARATION FOR HIS CONTRIBUTION TO A POSSIBLE TIME COVER STORY ON CHEMICAL WARFARE. THE BRIEFING GIVEN WAS ESSENTIALLY THE SAME AS THAT PREVIOUSLY GIVEN TO NEWSWEEK CORRESPONDENT FRANK GIBNEY. NEWSWEEK SUBSEQUENTLY REFERRED TO THE EMBASSY UNIT IN ITS APRIL 2 ARTICLE ON CHEMICAL WARFARE NOTING "...THE GROWING SOPHISTICATED ABOUT LOOKING INTO REPORTS OF CHEMICAL WARFARE."

THE SUBSTANCE OF THE BRIEFING WAS ON THE METHODOLOGY BEING USED IN DATA COLLECTION. PREDICTABLY, THE REPORTER RAISED QUESTIONS REGARDING METHODOLOGY USED PRIOR TO ESTABLISHMENT OF THE UNIT. THESE QUESTIONS WERE NOT ANSWERED IN DETAIL. INSTEAD, THE REPORTER WAS URGED TO DISCUSS THE WORK OF DR. AMOS TOWNSEND DIRECTLY WITH HIM. OTHER INQUIRIES REGARDING EARLIER
