1. THE CBW TEAM'S PHYSICIAN WAS TELEPHONED BY DR. DAVID S. ALLISON, CANADIAN EPIDEMIOLOGIST, WHO IS CURRENTLY PART OF A CANADIAN TEAM CONDUCTING A CROSS SECTIONAL SURVEY OF REFUGEES AND THAI NATIONALS AND OBTAINING BIOLOGIC CONTROLS TO STUDY THE POSSIBLE PRESENCE OF TRICHOHEGENES (REFTEL A).
2. DR. ALLISON STATED THAT HE AND DR. J.C. HOCKIN WENT TO THE CHIANG KHAM REFUGEE CAMP, PAYAO PROVINCE ON THE THAI-LAO BORDER WHERE 4200 REFUGEES ARE CURRENTLY HELD IN A PERMANENT CAMP. THEY MET WITH THE DEPUTY MINISTRY OF INTERIOR OFFICER IN CHARGE AND THE NEWLY APPOINTED HMONG CAMP LEADER. THEY ALSO MET WITH THE PHYSICIANS WITHOUT BOUNDARIES (MSF) MEDICAL TEAM (TWO NURSES AND ONE PHYSICIAN) AND GAVE AN ORIENTATION OF THE "YELLOW RAIN" PROBLEM SINCE THE MSF WERE NOT AWARE OF THIS ISSUE. THEY GAVE THE U.S. JOINT CBW INVESTIGATIVE TEAM'S ADDRESS AND TELEPHONE NUMBER SO THAT THE TEAM COULD BE CONTACTED CONCERNING ANY REPORTS. THE CANADIAN TEAM DREW 12 BLOOD SPECIMENS (SIX FROM ALLEGED CBW VICTIMS CLAIMING EXPOSURE BETWEEN NOV 83 AND JAN 84).
3. DR. ALLISON MENTIONED THAT THEY CAME UP AGAINST THE USUAL RESISTANCE FROM THE HMONG LEADERSHIP AT CHIANG KHAM REFUGEE CAMP REGARDING THEIR ATTEMPTS TO OBTAIN A LARGE SCALE BLOOD DRAWING OF CONTROLS.
4. DR. ALLISON STATED THAT THE HMONG CAMP LEADER SUGGESTED THAT SAMPLING EQUIPMENT BE MADE AVAILABLE TO HIM SO HE COULD PASS IT ON TO LOCAL HMONG RESISTANCE GROUPS.
5. DR. ALLISON STATED THAT HE WILL FOLLOW-UP ON THE DEATH AT TA PRIK CAMP (SUDDEN DEATH AUTOPSY SPECIMEN

6. THE CANADIAN TEAM USED A HMONG MEDIC AT THE CAMP AS THEIR INTERPRETER.

7. THE CBW TEAM WILL VISIT CHIANG KHAM CAMP TO SUPPLY SAMPLING EQUIPMENT AS SOON AS THIS EQUIPMENT FROM CRDC.
