Dear Mat,

I wonder whether you managed to see Evan LeGuard on Monday and, if so, whether he was aware of the contents of Nixon's speech. You must be quite pleased with the consequences of yours and others agitation, even though the question of harassing agents has not been settled properly, and despite the fact that the proposals represent enlightened self interest more than anything else (not a bad motive and at least predictable). It so happens that I had proposed a motion to be sent by our branch for the annual conference of the Association of Scientific, Technical and Managerial Staffs. This is quite a powerful union though numerically not so large. I enclose a copy of the motion for your information. I think that it is still relevant and that if it were properly discussed and passed at the conference of the union it might have some effect.
