Dear Ambassador Jakobson:

It was a very great pleasure to meet you at dinner in Cambridge last week. Following our discussion, I enclose a copy of a paper entitled "Legal Aspects of the Geneva Protocol" by Thomas Buergenthal and R.R. Baxter. On page 39 the authors discuss the possibility that the interpretation of the Geneva Protocol might be clarified by an advisory opinion of the International Court of Justice.

The manuscript is not yet in final form but I have the authors' permission to circulate a few copies of the present draft. Within a week or two, the final version should be ready and I shall send you a copy at that time.

I also enclose for your possible interest a record of hearings on chemical and biological warfare recently held by a subcommittee of the House Committee on Foreign Affairs.
