Dear Joe,

Sometime ago I asked you if you knew any way in which I could cover at least part of my out-of-pocket costs in connection with preparing papers and conducting discussions on the control of chemical and biological weapons. It would be a very great help to me if I could obtain approximately \$1,000 to pay for travel, telephone and secretarial expenses over the past eight months.

Because much of what I have done on my own expense in the last few months has involved the preparation, distribution and discussion of two privately circulated papers on CBW, I include them with this letter.

I certainly don't want you to bother with this if it is any real trouble. However, if you know of support that I could obtain without putting anyone to great trouble, I would certainly appreciate it. As for the months ahead, I have obtained a small research grant from the American Academy of Arts and Sciences to maintain an information center on CBW and conduct researches on that subject.

You missed a good session at the Carnegie Endowment last Monday. I hope you can be there next time.
