

1. At the CSIS meeting in Washington on 6 October, in which he had participated:
  - a. LEDOGAR had started his presentation by saying there were 118 co-sponsors of the soon-to-be-tabled draft UNGA resolution commending the CWC, but after his talk his staff person Amy WHATNOT said there were now 124. India is a co-sponsor. Not yet on the list are Russia, China and Pakistan. MOODIE thinks they will join the CWC.
  - b. MOODIE said the CWC would probably be submitted to the Senate soon after signing.
  - c. Blair MURRAY gave a good presentation on the PrepCom.
  - d. Learnt that KHRIPUNOV of the Russian embassy is moving to some sort of job at the University of Georgia.
  - e. Both KREPON and OLSON sought to publicize their new organizations. Brad ROBERTS is positioning himself center stage.
2. Yesterday, TUQAN had told Matt that Arab-League solidarity will be maintained up until the signature conference, but thereafter signature of the CWC will be a matter for individual states. This had been agreed at the Arab League summit.
3. Johan SANTESSON is convening a meeting on CW allegations, 16-17 Dec 92, in Geneva and wants Matt to participate. Under Pugwash colours, if needs be (i.e. if the US CD delegation won't sponsor him).
4. He pressed me to come over in time to meet his Sverdlovsk Russians, who leave at 1945 hrs on 13 October.
